I had been in agony at my mother's suffering during that time. All I could do is to accompany her when she conducts her treatment and visits the doctor. Right then I received my letter of recruitment from the military; the first thought that came into my mind was "what about my mum?" But my mum told me that her treatment has reached a certain stage and told me to leave at ease. When I reported to the military I realized that everything is so different here, a new environment, new habit, new people and event. At that moment I felt like a newborn baby, ready to start a new life (of course that includes the crew cut I just received)! I used to think I have faced many

difficulties before the national service and thought I will have no problem living independently, but the great diversity in the army made me feel like a tiny frog living in my own well.

In the army there are variety of people who skip classes, people who has their own company, students who just graduated overseas, but the only similarities we had were that everyone was called to join the army at the same time. Some people say that the national service is a waste of time since you won't be able to learn anything there, but to me the most important thing while serving the army is how to not feel tired, the rest is up to the mind on how to get through this one year. Within our department I feel that human interaction is something very important, specially in this case where everyone is treated equal, wear the same clothes but with different personality. It was pretty amazing to find that people are like color, some are red (outgoing) some are blue (people who are blue), and with the addition of other colors we form a whole different color. It seems like we are here to learn how to mix different colors, and how to fill up with colors that we want us to be.

Even though the national service has forced me to leave my home, the distance did helped bind our feelings deeper and made the family closer. A short telephone call can help me express my concerns to my family and also made me care for my family more. I no longer waste my holiday; instead I have learned how to plan for my break. Maybe different background creates different habits, and habits will lead to different personality, but the life here will change a person's habit! This is why human is in charge of their own life – because a person will change, and will eventually grow up!
