本署自89年1月28日成立,並在107年4月28日改隸於海洋委員會迄今,持續職司臺灣地區海域及海岸秩序與資源之維護,並戮力執行「海域治安」、「維護漁權」、「救生救難」、「海洋事務」及「海洋保育」五大核心任務,以落實執行三安(國安、治安、平安)、守護四海(海洋污染防治、海洋生態保育、海洋廢棄物治理、海洋產業發展)責任。近年面對周遭海域局勢與主權、漁權紛爭、極端天候與大型複合式災難之海事威脅,為維護我國海洋權益,保護國人生命財產安全,確保海洋資源之永續發展,本署賡續提升各項勤(業)務執行效能,依海域情勢,超前部署及彈性靈活調派艦艇,以維漁民作業權益及安全;積極整合相關機關能量,運用跨境犯罪情資及科技裝備,加強查緝走私偷渡不法活動,維護海域、海岸安全;強化區域救援機制,培育海上救援專業人力,充實海上災害防救能量,維護人民生命財產安全。致無論在近海及遠洋巡護、查緝走私與偷渡、海上救難、海洋環境保護、生態保育,以及為民服務工作等,都具有高度成效,並獲得社會大眾高度肯定。

為使社會各界瞭解本署各項任務執行成果與機關發展,本署自 91 年起按年編印海巡統計年報,藉以呈現本署業務績效、人員統計及預算編製情形。97 年起全書刊以中、英文對照方式呈現,105 年起又因應資訊技術發展,並落實政府節能減紙政策,海巡統計年報停印紙本,僅以電子書刊方式發布。113 年海巡統計年報內容循例以歷年海巡統計年報架構為基礎,分為提要分析、統計表及附錄等3部分,登載於本署全球資訊網,供各界查考錄用。由於資料範圍廣泛,若有疏漏之處,尚祈各界指正,無任感幸。

Preface

Established on January 28, 2000, the Coast Guard Administration (CGA) was placed under the Ocean Affairs Council on April 28, 2018. Since then, it has been responsible for safeguarding maritime order in Taiwan's waters, protecting marine resources, and implementing five core missions: Public Security in Sea Areas, Maintenance of Fishery Rights, Lifesaving and Rescue, Marine Affairs, and Marine Conservation. Through these efforts, the CGA upholds the principles of National Security, Public Safety, and Maritime Peace, while also advancing initiatives such as Marine Pollution Prevention, Ecological Conservation, Waste Management, and Sustainable Industry Development.

In the past year, in the face of maritime threats from the surrounding sea area, sovereignty disputes, extreme weather and large-scale complex disasters, in order to solve the complex sovereignty, fishing rights disputes and maritime issues, protect our maritime rights and interests, safeguard the lives and properties of our nationals and ensure the sustainable development of maritime resources, the CGA has continued to improve the performance efficiency of various services (business), and deployed its vessels flexibly and ahead of schedule according to the sea situation to safeguard the rights and safety of fishermen's operations; Actively integrate the energy of relevant agencies, making use of cross-border criminal intelligence and technological equipment, to strengthen the investigation and detection of smuggling and illegal activities, and maintain the safety of sea areas and coastlines; strengthen the regional rescue mechanism, cultivate professional manpower for marine rescue, enrich the energy for the prevention and rescue of marine disasters, and ensure the safety of people's lives and property. Whether in offshore and marine patrolling, smuggling and illegal entry/exit interdiction, marine rescue, marine environmental protection, ecological conservation or human service work, they are highly effective and highly appreciated by the public.

In order to let all sectors of society understand the result of CGA's business and its development, CGA has prepared the Annual Statistics Report every year since 2002 to show the status of CGA's business performance, personnel statistics and budget planning. This annual statistics report has been published in both Chinese and English versions since 2008, but has only been published electronically since 2016 in response to IT development and the implementation of energy efficiency and paper reduction policies. The 2024 CGA Annual Statistical Report, as usual based on the structure of the Annual Statistical Report over the years, is divided into three parts as summary analysis, statistical tables and annexes. The Chinese and English reports will be available on CGA's World Wide Web for use by all circles. As the materials are extensive, if there are any omissions, your corrections and instructions are highly appreciated.
