

前 言

本署自 89 年 1 月 28 日成立，並在 107 年 4 月 28 日改隸於海洋委員會迄今，持續肩負維護臺灣地區海域及海岸秩序、資源保護利用、確保國家安全、保障人民權益之職責，並戮力執行「海域治安」、「維護漁權」、「救生救難」、「海洋事務」及「海洋保育」五大核心任務，以落實執行三安（國安、治安、平安）、守護四海（海洋污染防治、海洋生態保育、海洋廢棄物治理、海洋產業發展）責任。近年我國周遭海域情勢愈趨複雜，區域安全不穩定因素持續升高，面對灰色地帶威脅、跨國犯罪集團海上活動頻繁，為捍衛國家主權、確保海事安全，致力維護我們海域的穩定秩序及守護國人海上生命財產權，本署積極提升執法能量及監偵效能，以透過國際合作，全力捍衛國家安全；應用智慧科技嚴厲查緝走私、偷渡活動，深化與國內外執法機關交流，共同打擊犯罪和維護社會治安；持續精進救援裝備及強化應變機制，落實海上遇險救援與災害防救應處，俾保障人民平安。致無論在近海及遠洋巡護、查緝走私與偷渡、海上救難、海洋環境保護、生態保育，以及為民服務工作等，都具有高度成效，並獲得社會大眾高度肯定。

為使社會各界瞭解本署各項任務執行成果與機關發展，本署自 91 年起按年編印海巡統計年報。97 年起全書刊以中、英文對照方式呈現，105 年起又因應資訊技術發展，並落實政府節能減紙政策，海巡統計年報停印紙本，僅以電子書刊方式發布。114 年海巡統計年報內容循例以歷年海巡統計年報架構為基礎，分為提要分析、統計表及附錄等 3 部分，登載於本署全球資訊網，供各界查考錄用。由於資料範圍廣泛，若有疏漏之處，尚祈各界指正，無任感幸。

Preface

Established on January 28, 2000, the Coast Guard Administration (CGA) was reorganized under the Ocean Affairs Council on April 28, 2018. The CGA continues to shoulder the responsibility of maintaining maritime and coastal order in the Taiwan Area, protecting and utilizing resources, ensuring national security, and safeguarding the rights and interests of the people. It focuses on five core missions: Maritime Security, Maintenance of Fishery Rights, Search and Rescue, Marine Affairs, and Marine Conservation. Through these efforts, the CGA upholds the principles of National Security, Public Safety, and Maritime Peace, while also advancing initiatives such as Marine Pollution Prevention, Ecological Conservation, Waste Management, and Sustainable Industry Development.

In recent years, maritime situations surrounding our nation have become increasingly complex, with rising instability in regional security. In the face of grey zone threats and frequent maritime activities by transnational criminal groups, the CGA remains dedicated to defending national sovereignty and ensuring maritime safety. To safeguard the stability of our waters and the lives and property of our citizens, the CGA has continuously enhanced its law enforcement capacity and surveillance efficiency. Through international cooperation, we stand firm in defending national security. By leveraging smart technology and deepening exchanges with domestic and foreign law enforcement agencies, we strictly crack down on smuggling and human trafficking to maintain social order. Furthermore, we continue to refine our rescue equipment and strengthen response mechanisms to ensure effective maritime search, rescue, and disaster prevention, thereby guaranteeing the safety of the people. Whether in offshore and marine patrolling, smuggling and illegal entry/exit interdiction, marine rescue, marine environmental protection, ecological conservation or human service work, they are highly effective and highly appreciated by the public.

To provide the public with a comprehensive understanding of the Coast Guard Administration's (CGA) operational achievements and organizational development, the CGA has published the Annual Statistical Report every year since 2002. Since 2008, the report has been published in a bilingual Chinese-English format. Furthermore, in response to information technology advancements and to align with the government's energy-saving and paper-reduction policies, the printed version was discontinued in 2016, and the report is now issued exclusively as an e-book. The 2025 CGA Annual Statistical Report maintains its established structure, consisting of three parts: Summary Analysis, Statistical Tables, and Appendices. These materials are available on the CGA official website for public reference. While every effort has been made to ensure accuracy, we welcome any corrections or suggestions from all sectors of society.
